

2016 POOL SEASON:

Saturday, May 28, 2016 - Monday, September 5, 2016

- ❖ The following rules have been established to ensure the efficient operation of the pool and to provide enjoyment to all residents. Parents are requested to review all rules with children and encourage them to obey the instructions of pool attendants. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in the loss of pool privileges for the current season.

- ❖ **PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION:**

Every home owner must register at the CCHA office and receive a red tag with a number.

An Illinois Driver's License or an Illinois State ID that shows the picture, address, and birth date of the resident will be required to receive a pool tag. Children 13 years to 17 years must show proof of age to swim without an adult present. A school ID or copy of a Birth Certificate will be required.

New or Replacement of lost Pool Tag is \$5.00.

- ❖ **POOL HOURS**

Adults ages 18 and above may swim without a lifeguard present ONLY if the office is open and the Manager is on premise during the hours of 9:00AM to 12:00PM. This is not permanent and subject to being discontinued at any time if necessary.

Regular hours – May 31 - August 23

Monday through Friday - 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM

Saturday, Sundays, and Holidays - 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM

Starting **August 24 through September 2**, there will be **shorter pool hours on weekdays only, (when children are back in school): 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM.**

- The pool may be closed due to adverse weather conditions, temperatures below 70°, mechanical breakdown or other operational difficulties, at the discretion of the pool attendant or office manager.

- ❖ **USE OF THE POOL AREA WITHOUT THE PRESENCE OF A POOL ATTENDANT IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**

Pool attendants have the authority to enforce the pool regulations and may temporarily ban any residents and/or their guests for violation of these rules. A Board review will follow after the incident. Attendants will not tolerate aggressive activity either physical or verbal, profanity or other unacceptable behavior towards themselves or others at the pool or clubhouse.

❖ **USE OF THE POOL AND RELATED FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTS OF CHESAPEAKE COMMONS AND THEIR GUESTS.**

Privileges are not extended to absentee owners. All owners, absentee owners and tenants must be in good standing to use the facilities. Residents must have a telephone number and homeowners insurance on file with the office and be current with all dues and fines. All tenants must have current leases (with expiration dates on lease) and completed and signed rental agreement forms on file to use the facilities.

❖ **CHILDREN YOUNGER THAN 13 YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT TO ENTER AND STAY AT THE POOL.**

Adult's proof of age must be available at time of check in. The adult must stay with the children at all times while at the pool. If you must leave the pool area for any reason, the child or children under the age of 13 years old must leave the pool area also. Pool attendants are NOT babysitters.

❖ **Children ages 13 years and above may use the pool without an adult as long as the children follow all the rules, behave appropriately, be respectful to other swimmers, and listen to the POOL ATTENDANTS. No yelling, foul language, running on pool deck, pushing or rough housing will be allowed. These privileges of swimming without a parent or other adult present may be suspended or even revoked at any time and for any reason deemed by the lifeguard and/or manager and the violators will be sent home. Safety is of the utmost importance at all times so these rules will be enforced.**

❖ **THERE IS A LIMIT OF 10 GUESTS PER UNIT**

If a resident exceeds the limit of ten guests the resident will be required to rent the clubhouse. If the clubhouse is already rented, we may need to deny entrance to all of your guests due to the limit of people allowed at the pool.

❖ **ANYONE FOUND JUMPING OVER THE FENCE WILL BE FINED \$115.00 BY CCHA**

Pool privileges will be suspended for a period of time to be determined by the Board of Directors.

❖ **EVERYONE USING THE POOL MUST SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING**

Hair longer than chin-length will be required to be tied back during use of pool.

❖ **PROPER SWIMWEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.**

Street shoes, cutoffs, boxer shorts, etc., are not permitted. White or light colored tee shirts will be allowed to help prevent sunburn.

❖ **ADMISSION WILL BE REFUSED TO ANYONE WITH SKIN ABRASIONS, INFLAMED EYES, INFECTIONS, COMMUNICABLE DISEASES, OR WEARING BANDAGES.**

❖ **ALL FOOD AND ANY GLASS CONTAINERS ARE PROHIBITED IN THE POOL AREA.**

This is an Illinois Department of Public Health regulation and if violated may be cause for our pool to close. An area for eating will be available inside the clubhouse.

❖ **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

No alcohol shall be sold, used or available in or around the pool facilities. Immediate loss of clubhouse or pool privileges will result if a Member, their families, or guest violate this rule. Anyone APPEARING intoxicated will be asked to leave the pool at the discretion of the CCHA pool attendant.

❖ **ONLY DIAPERS DESIGNED FOR SWIMMING ARE ALLOWED.**

Regular diapers are not acceptable under any circumstance. Only swim diapers (those specifically made for swimming pools) can be used.

❖ **SWIMMING ACCESSORIES**

Kick boards, tubes, water balls, etc. will be permitted at the discretion of the pool attendant and may be denied depending on the size of the accessory and pool occupancy.

❖ **DIVING IS NOT ALLOWED IN ANY AREA OF THE POOL**

Dunking, running, pushing, wrestling, screaming or any activities that may cause undue disturbances will not be permitted.

➤ **Any injuries occurring in the pool area must be immediately reported to the pool attendant.**

❖ The Association will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of any kind to personal property.

❖ All persons will use the facility at their own risk and in compliance with established rules and regulations. Anyone may be barred from the pool area at the discretion of the pool attendant for violation of these rules or for other reasons which, in their judgment, constitute a hazard to others or the Association.

❖ All persons using the pool or clubhouse areas shall do so at their own risk and sole responsibility with respect to accident or injury in connection with such use. Members shall be personally responsible for any personal injuries sustained by a Member, their families, their guest(s) or invitees and shall indemnify and hold the Association harmless for any claim, controversy or causes of action resulting from any acts, errors or omissions of Members, the Member' family, guests or invitees, in any way arising from the use of the Clubhouse or Pool Facilities.

❖ The CCHA Clubhouse and swimming pool including the pool deck is a **smoke free** facility.

***NOTE:** The current rules in effect are meant to be as all-inclusive as situations allow. They may, however, be revised at the discretion of the Community Association Manager, Pool Manager or the Board of Directors to address and amend specific situations. Posting of these rules is considered giving notice to all swimmers of these rules.*
